### Author Symposium

After much discussion about revamping the BAYA Author Symposium, the following changes were agreed upon:

- Keep the same basic format for 2005 except have it in on a Saturday in October at Berkeley Public Library, with teen entertainment and door prizes.
- For 2006, change to an all-day symposium or institute format. Get a grant from Margaret Edwards Trust to help fund the institute/symposium. Include teachers in planning and target symposium to them as well as librarians. Have teen participation. Possibly have at the same time as a bookseller's conference to have more authors available.
